How to Grow Your Mustard Seeds

<i>Your Mustard Seeds</i>	<i>Your Financial Seed</i>
<p>1. Planting Phase</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Plant about 2 seeds ¼” in the soil, 8” apart.• Gently cover the seeds with ¼” soil (compost) <p>2. Growth Phase</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Water mustard seeds weekly (2” per week)• Add balanced fertilizer to the root once the plants are 3” – 4” tall <p>3. Harvest Phase</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Mustard seeds take about 45 days to harvest. They are ready to harvest when the pods start to turn brown or the leaves start to turn yellow.• Remove the seeds from the pods. The pods will open on their own in 1 – 2 weeks. <p>Mustard seeds can be used fresh. If you plan to store them for long-term use, make sure to dry them out.</p>	<p>1. Planting Phase</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Get present with your money. Understand how you interact with money, what your debt triggers are, and get clear on your financial goals for the next 1, 3, 5, 10 and 20 years. <p>2.
